Baltimore, MD (January 31, 2009) — The results of the 2009 Baltimore area kosher survey conducted by Kosher Community Surveys LLC have just been released. The survey asked local consumers their opinions of Baltimore area kosher stores, restaurants, and bakeries. Overall winners are:

Best Kosher Restaurant:	David Chu's China Bistro
Best Kosher Bakery:	Goldman's Kosher Bakery
Best Kosher Store:	Wasserman & Lemberger

This same set of establishments also won last year. Other establishments with strong showings include: Pariser's Bakery, Umami Bistro, and Shlomo's Kosher Meat Market. Neil Rosenbaum, President of Kosher Community Surveys LLC, commented, "Baltimore kosher consumers continue to demonstrate greater interest in providing feedback to the area's kosher establishments. Approximately 430 people participated in this year's survey – an increase of over 100 surveys."
