Top Survey of Boston Area Kosher Establishments**

Boston, MA (August 8, 2007) — The results of the second annual Boston area kosher survey conducted by Kosher Community Surveys LLC have just been released. The survey, conducted this summer, asked local consumers about their opinions on Boston area kosher stores, restaurants, and bakeries. Overall winners are:

Best Kosher Restaurant:	Milk Street Cafe
Best Kosher Bakery (tie):	Stop & Shop Cheryl Ann's
Best Kosher Store:	Gordon & Alperin

Other establishments with strong ratings include Ta'am China, Rosenfeld's Bagels, and the Butcherie. Neil Rosenbaum, President of Kosher Community Surveys LLC, observed, "Consumer interest in this year's survey was impressive - almost 400 people participated in this year's survey, a 33% increase from last year."

The results of the survey have been published in a final report that can be found on the Kosher Community Surveys LLC's website.
