There were some notable establishment closings since our last Philadelphia survey such as Yi-Tzi Peking, Weiss Bakery, and Klapholtz Deli (now a catering service). The current economy will put pressure on other kosher establishments – the best response by these organizations will be to address their customers’ needs.
